

Line Management

 Providing clear day to day direction to 2 Fundraising Coordinators against conflicting priorities to ensure delivery of the Community Fundraising team's objectives.

Supporter Development and Project Delivery

- Produce engaging on and off-line fundraising products, tools and materials for a community fundraising audience using audience and sector insight.
- Monitoring and evaluating outgoing communications from the centralised Community Fundraising Support Function ensuring quality and timeliness to ensure a great supporter experience.
- Deliver centralised Community Fundraising Communications including Website Updates, Supporter Journey's, Mass Communications and Marketing Campaigns to drive donor acquisition and retention.

Team Support

- Maintain all central community fundraising policies and procedures ensuring they are up to date, clear, simple, concise and compliant in line with our organisational requirements.
- Drive improvements to systems and tools to create efficiency within the community fundraising team
- Be responsible for fulfilment procedures for Fundraising Materials i.e. our Your Way Pack, managing the end to end processes, within agreed budgets and maintaining and developing relationships with third party suppliers.

- Represent the Community Fundraising team on internal project groups.
- Provide support to the Senior Community Fundraising Manager as required.
