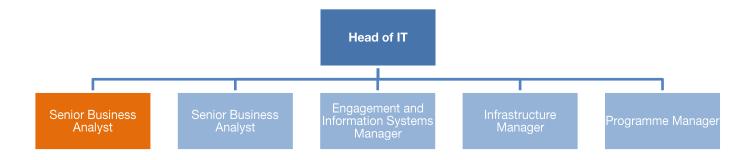
OVERALL PURPOSE OF THE JOB

Diabetes UK is bringing people together to work in partnership in order to support those living with diabetes, prevent Type 2, make research breakthroughs in diabetes and ultimately, find a cure. In order to achieve our organisational needs and how IT can be used to provide solutions, it is essential to have a strong IT business analysis team. We're looking for a 'starter finisher' with an excellent level of Business Analysis experience that can effectively and efficiently manage the definition, analysis, delivery and maintenance of business, project and system requirements and in some situations see a project through to delivery. They'll support transformation and change projects.

The Senior Business Analyst role is responsible for:

- Working with key stakeholders, users and subject matter experts to elicit and document needs, constraints, concerns, and risks.
- Preparing business requirements, documenting 'As Is' and 'To Be' processes and delivering process flows.
- Developing functional and non-functional requirements for assigned projects.
- Define the systems design in order to fulfil requirements.
- Completing the documentation, analysis and design of proposed solutions.
- Generating a set of acceptance test requirements, together with the developers, and users, which determine that all of the high level requirements have been met.
- Performing cost-benefit analyses to determine whether requirements are best met by new or existing systems or processes.
- Supporting the project team throughout the project lifecycle and as such will be an integral part of the team as well as working with multiple stakeholders.
- Interfacing with the design and implementation developers, so that any problems arising during design or implementation can be resolved in accordance with the fundamental design concepts, and user needs.
- Providing direction and guidance for Junior Business Analysts assigned to project teams as well as working with other Senior Business Analysts to define the best solutions.

MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To take design ownership for Diabetes UK's data lifecycle with regards to the charity's customer relationship management systems. Ensuring that all of the systems, processes, and solutions have clear development roadmaps and that these are agreed and communicated with the stakeholders.
- To ensure that all documentation is accurate and sufficient and that changes to requirements are properly managed and communicated to all relevant parties.
- To develop a deep understanding of the information architecture for customer data across the charity to be able to identify opportunities for improvement and to understand the impacts of new ideas that the charity may wish to adopt.
- Facilitate decision making in projects that will often link directly to key strategic goals with cross-organisational priorities
- To lead on the delivery of high quality and efficient data acquisition and data capture supporting business objectives through data acquisition to analysis.
- To ensure that appropriate validation and data quality assurance processes are developed, implemented and maintained, as well as developing more robust processes.
- To work with technical teams to provide organizational leadership for data acquisition and processing services to data usage and analysis championing the importance of information systems, the data they hold and the need for business analysis.
- Ensure good governance by employing industry recognised Change Control procedures.
- Gathering and documentation of user requirements and advising on technical considerations

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- Assist Business managers in projects requiring reporting facilities to measure KPI's and project effectiveness.
- Identify and recommend improvements to organizational processes, specifically related to business analysis
- Embrace Diabetes UK volunteering activities through involving volunteers in your work and own participation through active volunteering within Diabetes UK.
- Undertake other work as might reasonably be required by the Information Systems Team
- Provide guidance to other business analysts on industry standards as well as ways of working within Diabetes UK
